## CROP CALENDAR FOR OUTDOOR KENTUCKY SCHOOL GARDENS

Data from the following tables is from the University of Kentucky Cooperative Extension Service publication ID-128 Home Vegetable Gardening in Kentucky. Since many schools are not in session over the summer, here are a few crops that can be planted and harvested in the fall and spring. Be sure to read seed or plant information for best results. Weather and temperature will also impact exact harvest date.
